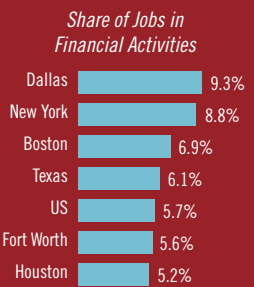
The finance and insurance industry, bundled with accounting, makes up the **6th largest** sector by employment in the DFW area, averaging **24,300 new hires** per year.

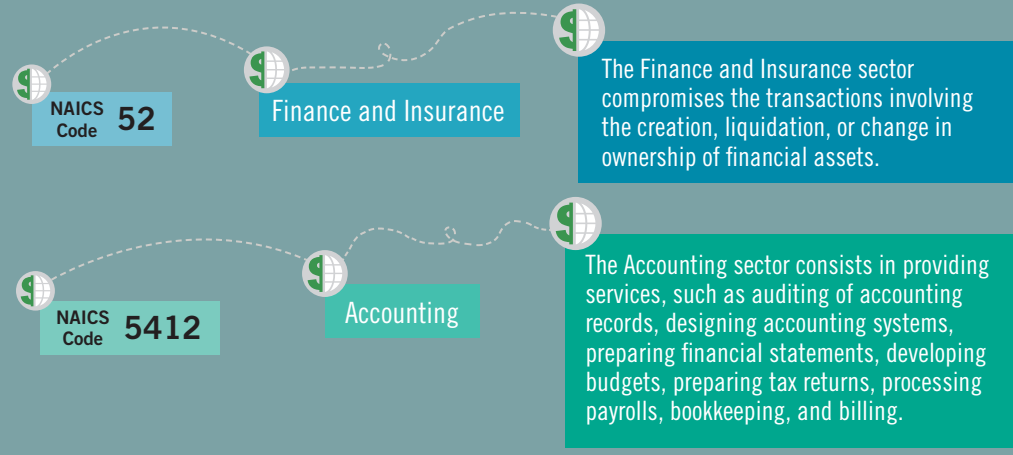


HIGH FINANCE IN DALLAS

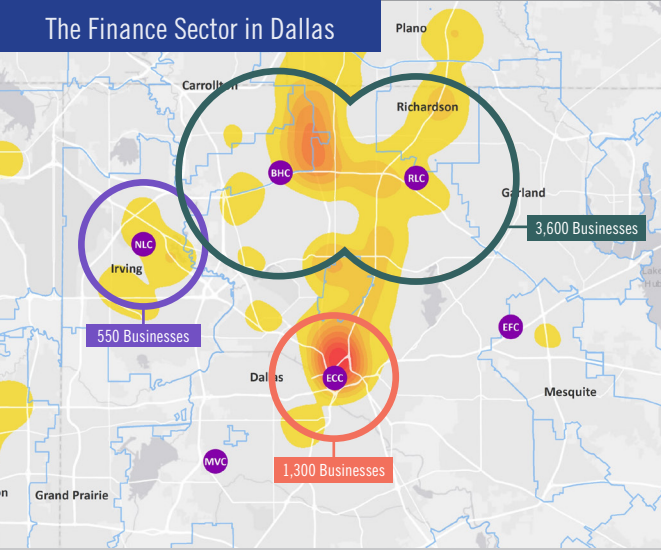

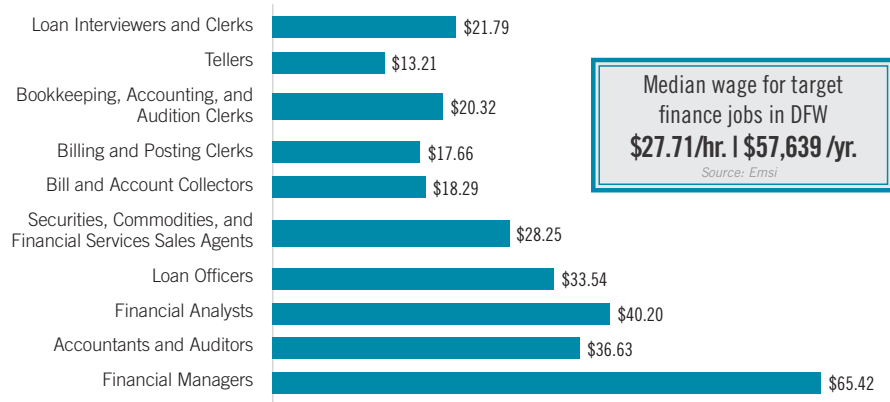
